Even though your pupils may swim in another year please report on their attainment on leaving primary school at the end of the summer term 2021.</p>	90 % in 2021
<p>What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?</p>	90% in 2021
<p>What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?</p>	100% Personal rescue is part of the annual training at Stowmarket pool, and one child did not attend.

Have you used it in this way?</p> <p>N.B. 100% is based on pupils swimming level in year 4/5 as due to Covid restrictions they did not swim in 2020/21 but proved competent at all levels prior to the pandemic.</p>	Yes, pupils still access swimming over and above the national curriculum requirements, which has meant that they learn to swim to a high standard and many pupils go on to join local swimming clubs outside of school
