Music

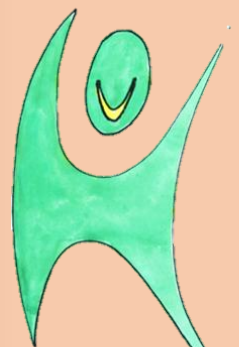
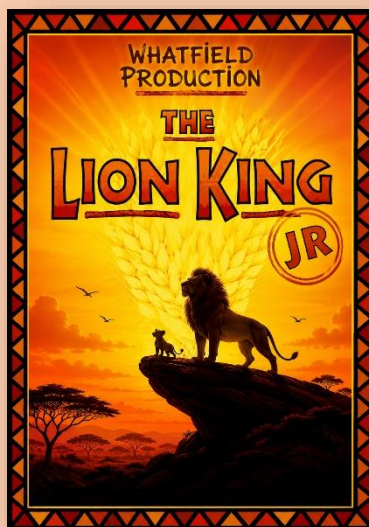
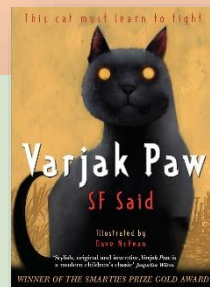
Miss Simmons will be working on the songs for the upcoming Summer Show, Lion King!

Spanish

Las Verduras - In this unit pupils will learn 10 common vegetables in their plural form with their definite articles. They will learn the basic transactional language required take part in a role-play activity based on buying different quantities of vegetables from a market stall.

Maths

The Year 5's will be working on shape and position and direction

Year 6 will be working on ratio and algebra

Art - Sculpture and 3D

Creating a personal memory box using a collection of found objects and hand-sculptured forms, reflecting primary school life with symbolic and personal meaning.

PE

PE this half term will be striking and fielding. This will include various forms of cricket and of course every summer's favourite sport, rounders!

Science - How does light affect the direction of plant growth?

This half term in Science, Oaks will revisit key learning from across Upper Key Stage 2. The children will explore life cycles, classification, evolution and inheritance, as well as investigating forces such as gravity, friction and air resistance. They will also build and test electrical circuits using a range of components and develop their scientific enquiry skills by carrying out investigations and drawing conclusions from their results.

PSHE

We will look at our sex education module and then move onto managing change. The students will look at the difference between male and female anatomy and look at changes that happen especially puberty. Year 6's will lead from puberty into a focus on sexual intercourse and the human lifecycle. They will also look at how puberty brings about change in emotion. They will all finish off by learning about the importance of personal hygiene.
